

100Mbps switches connect gigabit networks



Article Overview

100Mbps switches can connect to gigabit networks, but the connection will be limited to 100Mbps speeds on those links.

Compatibility and Performance

A 100Mbps switch can physically connect to a gigabit network because Ethernet standards are backward compatible. Devices on a gigabit network will auto-negotiate with the 100Mbps switch and operate at the maximum speed supported by the slower device, which is 100Mbps in this case . This means that while the network can still function, any traffic passing through the 100Mbps switch will be bottlenecked at 100Mbps, even if other parts of the network support gigabit speeds .

Cable Considerations

- Cat5e cables can support gigabit speeds, but all 8 wires must be intact and properly connected. A 100Mbps switch only uses 4 wires, so connecting it to a gigabit network will not utilize the full cable potential .
- Cat6 cables are recommended for gigabit networks to ensure reliable performance and reduce crosstalk, especially if future upgrades are planned .
- Using a 100Mbps switch with Cat6 or Cat5e cables will work, but the link speed will still be limited to 100Mbps.
