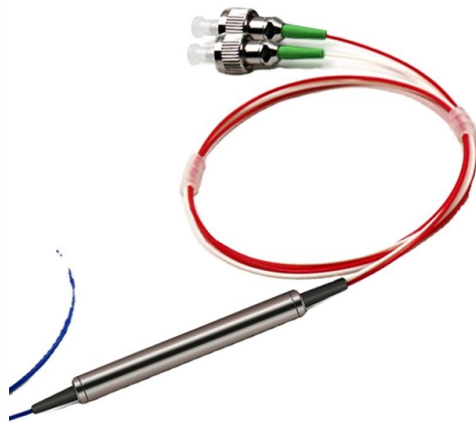

100G optical cables use either single-mode or multimode fiber with connectors like LC or MPO, supporting distances from meters to tens of kilometers depending on fiber type and transceiver.

Fiber Types

Single-mode fiber (SMF) has a small core diameter (~9 microns) and transmits light in a single path, minimizing modal dispersion. This makes SMF ideal for long-distance applications, such as telecommunications or intercontinental networks, supporting 100G links up to 10 km or more depending on the transceiver type . Multimode fiber (MMF) has larger core diameters (50-62.5 microns) and transmits multiple light modes simultaneously. MMF is typically used for shorter distances, such as within data centers, with link lengths ranging from 20 m to 100 m depending on the fiber grade (OM3 or OM4) and transceiver . MMF is generally less expensive for short-reach applications but suffers from higher modal dispersion over longer distances.

Connector Types

Common 100G optical connectors include:

- LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, widely used for duplex single-mode or multimode connections .
- MPO/MTP (Multi-fiber Push-On): Combines 12-24 fibers in a single connector, commonly used for parallel optics in 100GBASE-SR4 or SR10 links .
- SC, ST, FC: Less common in modern 100G deployments but still supported in som...
