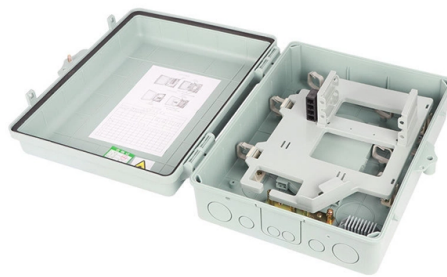

The term "all-dielectric" means the cable contains no metal components, which eliminates risks of induced currents, short circuits, or galvanic corrosion when installed near energized power lines . Its self-supporting design simplifies installation, reduces costs, and allows spans ranging from 50 meters to over 1,500 meters depending on the cable type .

Construction

ADSS cables typically include:

- Optical fibers housed in loose buffer tubes or ribbon configurations, which protect fibers from strain and maintain low optical loss .
- Aramid yarn (Kevlar or equivalent) strength members that provide tensile strength and elongation properties, allowing the cable to withstand wind, ice, and UV exposure .
- Outer jacket made of polyethylene (PE) or anti-tracking (AT) material to protect against moisture, UV radiation, and environmental degradation
