Choosing the Right Limit Switch Box

- **Capacity:** Most boxes can accommodate 2-4 switches, with some allowing solenoid valve connections or dual circuits for cost-effective setups .

Installation Considerations

- **Mounting:** Limit switch boxes are typically mounted on the top flange of actuators or inside distribution boxes. Ensure the mounting surface is flat and secure .
- **Wiring:** Use the provided terminal strips or connection points for clean and organized wiring. Some boxes feature angled terminal strips for easier access .
- **Visual Feedback:** Many boxes include LED indicators or mechanical position domes to show switch status, which helps in monitoring valve or actuator positions .
- **Adjustments:** Quick-set cams or spring-mounted shafts allow fine-tuning of switch positions and compensation for height tolerances
