

# All distribution boxes must be grounded

Yes, all distribution boxes, especially metallic ones, must be grounded to ensure safety, equipment protection, and code compliance.

### Mandatory Grounding

Grounding of distribution boxes is required for all metallic enclosures. According to NEC 314.28, metal boxes must be reliably grounded and bonded, and NEC 250.148 specifies that metallic junction boxes and cabinet doors must be connected to ground using a designated grounding screw or clip. Non-metallic boxes generally do not require grounding unless they contain metallic frames, hinges, or components that could become energized.

### Purpose of Grounding

- Safety of personnel: It channels fault currents safely into the earth, reducing the risk of electric shock.
- Equipment protection: Grounding protects electrical components from lightning strikes, transient overvoltages, and fault currents.
