

All ground wires in household electrical distribution boxes



Article Overview

All ground wires in a household electrical box should be bonded together and connected to any metal boxes or devices to ensure a continuous low-impedance path for fault currents.

Purpose of Grounding

Ground wires, also called equipment grounding conductors, provide a safe path for electricity if a fault occurs, preventing shock or fire hazards. They connect all metal parts of the electrical system—including boxes, switches, outlets, and appliances—back to the main service panel and ultimately to a grounding electrode like a ground rod or water pipe, ensuring that fault currents trip breakers quickly and safely (Fine Homebuilding) .

Connecting Ground Wires in a Box

- All ground wires entering a box should be connected together using a wire nut or crimp connector. This includes grounds from incoming and outgoing circuits as well as any pigtails to devices (Inspectapedia) .
- If the box is metal, a ground wire must also be bonded to the box itself to maintain continuity. For plastic boxes, bonding to the box is not required, but all device grounds must still be interconnected (Inspectapedia) .
- In multi-gang boxes, you can create pigtails for each device, but all grounds must ultimately be electrically continuous within the box (Home Improvement Stack Exch...
