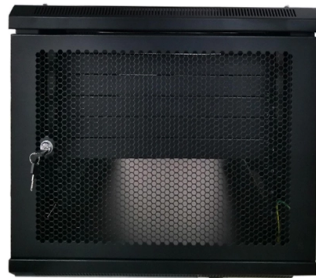

A data center is a secure facility that houses servers, storage systems, and networking equipment, designed to store, process, and manage vast amounts of digital information for businesses, cloud services, and public institutions . Instead of keeping data on individual devices, data centers centralize computing resources, enabling 24/7 access to websites, apps, and cloud services. Key components include servers, storage devices (HDDs and SSDs), networking equipment (routers, switches, firewalls), cooling systems, power backups, and security measures .

- Ensure reliability and security: Redundant power, cooling, and security systems prevent downtime and protect sensitive information .
- Reduce latency: Edge data centers bring data closer to users, improving response times for applications like gaming, streaming, and 5G services
