Explosion-Proof Considerations

Explosion-proof cable trays are designed to prevent sparks, contain potential ignition sources, and allow gases to escape safely. Open ladder-type trays are preferred in Zone 1 areas because their structure prevents gas accumulation. Stainless steel trays are often chosen in high-heat or corrosive environments, but they must be installed with ready-made fittings to avoid on-site welding, which could create sparks. In Zone 0, cable trays are generally not allowed, while in Zone 2, materials must resist static buildup and corrosion
