Proper assembly and wiring of explosion-proof low-voltage distribution boxes require adherence to safety standards, correct cable selection, grounding, and precise connection of switches and terminals.

Key Steps for Assembly and Wiring

1. Safety Precautions Before starting, ensure the electrical power supply is completely turned off to prevent electrocution or sparks. Use lockout/tagout procedures if available. Only qualified personnel should perform installation in hazardous areas, following national and international standards such as IEC, ATEX, or IECEx . 2. Selection of Components

- Use cables, connectors, and components certified for explosion-proof applications (EX or ATEX markings).
- Cables should be flame-resistant, impact-resistant, and mechanically robust to prevent sparks or arcs from escaping the enclosure .
- Enclosures are typically made from aluminum alloy, stainless steel (304/316L), or glass-reinforced polyester (GRP) to balance mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, and thermal conductivity . 3. Terminal Connections
- Connect incoming power cables to the designated terminal blocks for live, neutral, and earth wires.
- Ensure proper grounding using a dedicated earth terminal to safely direct stray currents and prevent fire or shock hazards
