Purpose and Application

A vertical downward bend is used when cables need to drop from ceilings, overhead trays, or elevated platforms to lower levels or the ground. This type of bend ensures that cables follow a controlled path, maintaining their integrity and preventing damage due to sharp angles or excessive stress. It is commonly applied in industrial, commercial, and data center installations where changes in elevation are required.

Installation Considerations

- **Bend Angle:** The tray is bent at a specific angle to allow a smooth descent. The angle should be gradual enough to prevent cable strain but sufficient to meet the required elevation change.
- **Bend Radius:** Maintain a proper bend radius according to cable specifications to avoid kinking or insulation damage. Larger radii are preferred for high-voltage or fiber optic cables.
- **Support:** Additional supports may be needed at the bend to maintain structural integrity and prevent sagging, especially for long cable runs.
- **Material and Type:** Steel, aluminum, or wire mesh trays can be bent using manual tools, bending machines, or pre-fabricated fittings. Wire mesh trays are flexible and can be custom-bent to precise angles
