Busbar trunking systems (BTS) provide a modular, flexible, and efficient method to distribute electrical power from a main supply to distribution cabinets and downstream loads.

Overview of Busbar Trunking Systems

Busbar trunking systems are prefabricated electrical distribution assemblies that consist of insulated conductors enclosed in a protective casing. They are designed to transport electrical power efficiently from a main supply to various distribution points, including distribution cabinets, switchgear, and tap-off units . BTS can handle a wide range of currents, from low-power systems (40–160 A) to high-power industrial applications (up to 6300 A), .

Connection to Distribution Cabinets

Busbar trunking connects to distribution cabinets through standardized interfaces, often using tap-off units or direct connections. The connection process involves:

- Alignment and mounting: The busbar trunking is mounted along walls, ceilings, or floors, ensuring proper alignment with the distribution cabinet entry points .
- Electrical connection: Conductors from the busbar trunking (live, neutral, and protective earth) are connected to the cabinet's busbars or terminals. This can be done via bolted connections or plug-in tap-off units rated for the system's current
