Cable Tray Specifications Overview

Parameter	Specification / Recommendation
Tray Types	Ladder, Solid Bottom, Ventilated, Wire Mesh, Channel
Materials	Steel (pre-galvanized, hot-dip galvanized), Aluminum, Stainless Steel (AISI 316L), Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic (FRP)
Finish / Coating	Powder-coated, epoxy-coated, or natural corrosion-resistant finishes depending on environment
Standard Lengths	10 ft (3 m) typical; custom lengths available
Rung / Support Spacing	Ladder tray: 6–9 in (150–230 mm); Wire mesh: 4–6 in (100–150 mm)
Load Capacity	Varies by tray width, material, and span; consult manufacturer tables for uniform load ratings
Tray Widths	Common: 4 in, 6 in, 8 in, 12 in, 18 in, 24 in; custom widths available
Bend Radius	Maintain minimum bend radius per cable type to prevent damage; typically 6–12 times cable diameter
Support / Span	Ladder tray: 5–10 ft (1.5–3 m) depending on load; Wire mesh: 3–5 ft (0.9–1.5 m)
Temperature Range	Standard steel: -20°C to 60°C; FRP: -40°C to 90°C; consult manufacturer for extreme conditions
Corrosion Considerations	Use stainless steel or FRP in corrosive environments; aluminum for moderate corrosion; galvanized steel for general use
Compliance Standards	NEC (NFPA 70), IEC 61537, NEMA VE 1, UL 568
