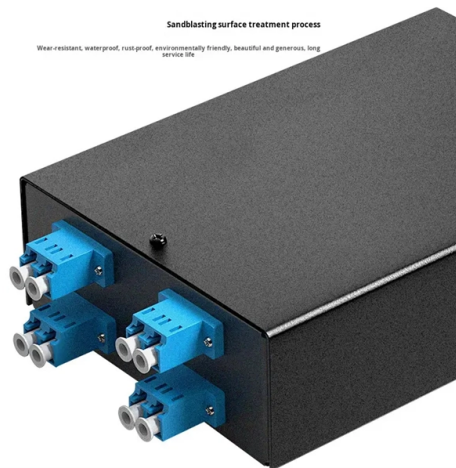

Cable Tray Types

Selecting the appropriate tray type is the first sub-item in installation. Common types include ladder trays, ventilated troughs, solid-bottom trays, and wire mesh trays. Ladder trays are preferred for heat dissipation and easy cable anchoring, while solid or ventilated trays are used for aesthetic or EMI-sensitive applications .

Support Systems

Proper support is critical for mechanical integrity. Sub-items include:

- Support spans: Determined based on manufacturer load charts and cable weight .
- Support methods: Trapeze hangers for ceiling suspensions, cantilever wall brackets for vertical runs .
- Mounting hardware: Bolts, brackets, and clamps suitable for the tray material and environment .

Grounding and Bonding

Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors (EGC) if installed per NEC requirements. Sub-items include bonding jumpers, grounding connections, and verification of continuity
