

Cable tray manufacturer s span standard



Article Overview

Cable tray support spans vary by tray type, load, and material, typically ranging from 6 to 20 feet for standard installations, with extra-long spans exceeding 20 feet.

Standard Span Classifications

Cable tray spans are generally classified based on the distance between supports:

- Short Span: Typically supported every 6 to 8 feet, used for non-industrial indoor installations .
- Intermediate Span: Supported every 10 to 12 feet, suitable for moderate loads and indoor applications .
- Long Span: Supported every 14 to 20 feet, often used in industrial or commercial settings where fewer supports are desired .
- Extra-Long Span: Exceeds 20 feet, commonly used outdoors to cross roads or reduce the number of expensive supports .

Factors Affecting Span

- Tray Type and Material: Ladder, ventilated, solid-bottom, and wire mesh trays have different load capacities. Materials like aluminum, steel, or fiberglass influence allowable spans .
- Load Class: Defined by NEMA or CSA standards, the load class (e.g., NEMA 12A, 12B, CSA C-3m, D-3m) determines the maximum support spacing for a given cable weight .
- Environmental Conditions: Outdoor installations may require shorter spans due to wind, snow, or ice loads
