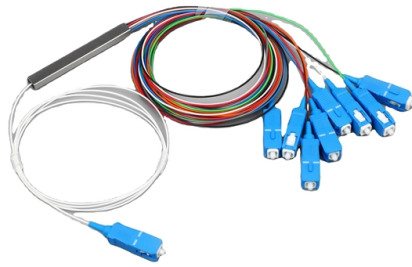


Calculating the quota for fiber optic cable running along the wall



Article Overview

To calculate the fiber optic cable quota along a wall, account for the wall length, slack for bends, minimum bend radius, and clamping intervals.

Steps to Calculate Cable Quota

1. Measure the Wall Length Start by measuring the total linear distance along the wall where the cable will be installed. Include any vertical or horizontal deviations, corners, or obstacles that the cable must navigate. 2. Add Slack for Bends and Turns Fiber optic cables must not be bent sharply. Maintain a minimum bend radius as specified by the manufacturer, typically 10 times the cable diameter for single-mode cables. For each corner or turn, add extra length to accommodate smooth curves without exceeding the bend radius . 3. Include Clamping and Support Intervals For vertical or horizontal wall runs, the cable should be clamped at regular intervals to prevent sagging and mechanical stress. Typical clamping intervals are 1-2 meters for horizontal runs and 0.5-1 meter for vertical runs, depending on cable weight and type . Add extra length to account for these mounting points. 4. Account for Service Loops and Termination Slack Include additional cable at both ends for termination, splicing, and future maintenance. A common practice is to add 1-2 meters at each end and figure-8 loops for slack along the run to prevent twisting and allow for adjustments . 5. Calculate Total Quota The total cable quota is the sum of:

- Measured wall length
- Extra length for bends and turns...
