

# Can a single-strand wire be run in a cable tray



## Article Overview

Single-strand wires can be installed in cable trays, but NEC Article 392 restricts the minimum size to 1/0 AWG unless the conductors are part of a listed tray cable assembly.

### NEC Requirements

According to NEC Article 392, cable trays are permitted for supporting various wiring methods, including single-conductor power cables, feeders, branch circuits, and control circuits (392.3) . However, the smallest single conductor allowed in a cable tray is 1/0 AWG unless the wire is part of a listed tray cable or bundled in a secondary product designed for tray use . Grounding conductors must be larger than 4 AWG but do not require special marking .

### Installation Considerations

- Tray Types: Ladder trays provide the best ventilation and support for single-conductor cables, while solid-bottom trays reduce ampacity due to limited airflow . Wire mesh (basket) trays are suitable for low-voltage or communication cables but can also support power conductors if properly rated .
- Support and Securing: Cables must be secured at intervals according to manufacturer instructions, and non-horizontal runs should be fastened to transverse members to prevent stress .
- Spacing and Fill: Single-conductor cables must comply with tray fill limits and amp...
