A three phase distribution box helps send electricity to many places. It connects to the main power and splits it into smaller circuits. The. The three-level distribution system refers to a system that distributes electric power through three levels of distribution devices from the incoming power line at the construction site to the electrical equipment. A primary distribution substation is the connection point of a distribution system to a trans-mission or a sub-transmission network. This device makes sure power goes to big machines safely and quickly. Big buildings with many floors. The electricity supply chain consists of three primary segments: generation, where electricity is produced; transmission, which moves power over long distances via high-voltage power lines; and distribution, which moves power over shorter distances to end users (homes, businesses, industrial sites. Generally, first level distribution does not allow direct use of electrical equipment, and second level distribution will be by power equipment because it is three-phase electricity, while third level distribution is mains electricity (220V).
