- **Redundancy and Reliability:** Core switches often require dual power supplies, redundant supervisors, or chassis-based designs to maintain uptime. Cheap switches may lack these features, increasing the risk of downtime.
- **Scalability:** A low-cost switch may have limited ports or fixed configurations, making future expansion difficult. Chassis-based or modular switches offer more flexibility but are more expensive.
- **Network Features:** Core switches often need advanced Layer 3 capabilities, routing protocols, and traffic management features. Budget switches may not support all re...
