

Can low-voltage wires be laid in cable trays



Article Overview

Yes, low-voltage wiring can be run through cable trays, provided the installation follows NEC guidelines and proper separation from higher-voltage cables is maintained.

NEC Compliance and Cable Tray Use

Cable trays are designed as support systems for various wiring types, including low-voltage systems such as communications, control, and signaling circuits (NEC Article 392.3) . Low-voltage cables rated 600 volts or less can be installed together in the same tray without additional separation, as long as tray fill, support, and securement requirements are met . For cables operating above 600 volts, a solid barrier or separate tray is required to prevent interference and maintain safety .

Cable Tray Selection for Low-Voltage Systems

When selecting a tray for low-voltage wiring, consider the following factors :

- **Cable Type and Diameter:** Include Cat6/6A/7, fiber optic, coaxial, and control cables, noting their outer diameters.
- **Total Quantity and Weight:** Plan for current and future expansion, typically adding 20–30% growth margin.
- **Bend Radius:** Ensure the tray accommodates the minimum bend radius for fiber optics and copper cables to prevent damage....
