- Full-body harnesses that distribute fall forces
  - Shock-absorbing lanyards
  - Helmets to protect against falling objects
  - Tool belts or lanyards to secure equipment and prevent dropped tools
- Climbing Techniques:** Maintain three points of contact at all times. Use fixed ladders or climbing devices where available. Secure all tools and materials to prevent falling hazards .
