Restricted Aisle Length: If one end of the aisle is closed off or lacks a personnel exit, the maximum aisle length should be limited to 6 meters for safe access and evacuation. Hot. The cold aisle layout is the most common starting point in data center design. The Modular system is physically attached to the rack, and features sliding doors with Lexan (polycarbonate) windows. It has aluminum profile roof panels that span the width of the design to accommodate non-uniform rack heights and.
