The standard 12-core optical fiber color sequence follows TIA-598-C: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua.

Standard 12-Fiber Color Sequence

For a 12-core fiber optic cable, each fiber is assigned a unique color to simplify identification during installation and splicing. The TIA-598-C standard specifies the following sequence:

- Blue
 - Orange
 - Green
 - Brown
 - Slate (Gray)
 - White
 - Red
 - Black
 - Yellow
 - Violet
 - Rose (Pink)
 - Aqua
- This sequence is used for both single-mode and multimode fibers, ensuring consistency across installations and reducing errors in high-density environments .
