What is an Optical Module

An optical module is a hot-pluggable transceiver used in high-bandwidth data communications to convert electrical signals into optical signals for transmission over fiber and to convert received optical signals back into electrical signals . It typically consists of:

- TOSA (Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts electrical signals to optical signals using a laser diode or LED .
- ROSA (Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts incoming optical signals back to electrical signals.
- Driver and TIA chips: Control signal modulation and amplification.
- PCBA (Printed Circuit Board Assembly): Houses the functional circuits and main control logic.
- Housing and interfaces: Provide electrical and optical connectivity to networking equipment . Optical modules operate at the physical layer of the OSI model and are essential in data centers, enterprise networks, and telecommunications systems .
