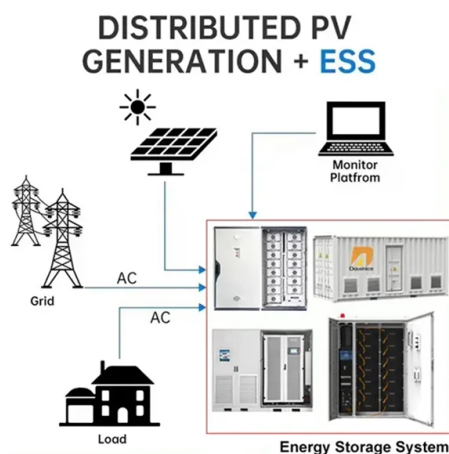


Commonly Used Aggregation Switches

Core Functions

Aggregation switches sit in the middle layer of a network, between access switches and core switches, often in a three-tier architecture (access, aggregation, core) in enterprise or data center networks. They collect traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or servers and funnel it upward to the core, reducing congestion and simplifying the core layer. This centralization allows for efficient traffic management, policy enforcement, and routing between VLANs.

Bandwidth and Redundancy

By using link aggregation protocols such as LACP or static link aggregation, aggregation switches can combine multiple physical links into a single logical connection. This provides higher bandwidth, load balancing, and failover capabilities in case of link failure. This makes them ideal for high-traffic environments where multiple users or devices generate significant network load.
