Fiber Color Coding Standards

Fiber optic networks use color coding systems to organize cables, strands, and connectors, which is essential for efficient installation, splicing, testing, and troubleshooting (). The most widely adopted standards are EIA/TIA-598-D and TIA-598-C, which define color codes for:

- Outer Cable Jackets – indicate fiber type and mode (e.g., OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5, OS2) ().
- Inner Fiber Strands – identify individual fibers within multi-fiber cables using a 12-color repeating sequence ().
- Connector Boots and Polishes – indicate fiber mode and polish type (e.g., blue = UPC, green = APC) ().
