It protects delicate fiber ends from mechanical stress, environmental damage, and bending that could degrade signal quality. Trays can accommodate fusion splices, mechanical splices, or pigtail connections, and are available in various sizes and configurations depending on network requirements .

Steps to Connect Fiber Optic Cable to a Splice Tray

- Prepare the Workspace
 - Ensure a clean, well-lit area to prevent contamination of fiber ends.
 - Gather necessary tools: fiber strippers, cleavers, fusion splicer or mechanical splice kit, and protective gloves .
- Prepare the Fiber Cable
 - Remove the outer jacket carefully without damaging the inner fibers.
 - Strip the fiber coating to expose the bare glass for splicing.
 - Clean the fiber with isopropyl alcohol to remove dust or oils .
- Splice the Fibers
 - Fusion splicing: Align fibers in a fusion splicer and use an electric arc to join them, creating a seamless connection with minimal loss....
