

Connect the ground wire to the distribution box



Article Overview

To connect a ground wire to a distribution box, attach a properly sized copper wire to the PE (protective earth) bar inside the box and ensure it is securely connected to a grounding electrode or rod.

Step-by-Step Procedure

1. Identify the Grounding Point: Open the distribution box and locate the grounding bar (PE bar), usually marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. This is the designated point for connecting the ground wire inside the box .
2. Prepare the Ground Wire: Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting local electrical codes (commonly 6 mm² or 10 AWG depending on the region), . Strip the insulation at the end to expose enough copper for a secure connection .
3. Connect the Ground Wire to the PE Bar: Insert the stripped end of the ground wire into the terminal on the PE bar and tighten the screw firmly with a screwdriver to ensure a solid connection . If there are electrical components inside the box that require grounding, connect them to the PE bar using additional copper wires .
4. Connect to the Grounding Electrode: Run the other end of the ground wire to a grounding electrode, such as a copper-clad steel rod driven into the earth, a buried metal water pipe, or a concrete-encased rebar. Ensure the connection is secure and continuous . Use a voltmeter to check that the ground resistance meets safety standards, typically below 0.1 ohm for industrial systems .
5. Verify and Label: After connecting, test the grounding using a voltmeter to confirm proper continuity and low resistance. Clearly label the grounding connections for future inspection and maintenance .
