

# Connection of fire protection network cable and cable tray

Fire protection network cables must be installed in fire-resistant cable trays with proper segregation, secure fixing, and compliance with relevant standards to ensure functionality during a fire.

### Cable Tray Selection and Installation

Cable trays for fire protection networks should be made of fire-resistant materials such as painted steel, stainless steel, or hot-dip galvanized steel for indoor and outdoor use, with aluminum or fiberglass-reinforced plastic for corrosive environments . The tray width and thickness must support the weight and number of cables without deformation . Routes should follow the shortest and straightest path, avoiding unnecessary crossings and detours, and should align with the building structure to facilitate maintenance .

### Fire-Resistant Cable Requirements

Cables used in fire protection networks must remain operational during a fire. Standard fire-resisting cables provide 30 minutes of survival, while enhanced fire-resisting cables can survive up to 120 minutes, suitable for high-risk or unsprinklered buildings, hospitals, and phased evacuation scenarios . Common types include mineral insulated copper (MI) cables and LSZH fire-resistant cables . Low-voltage (LV) and extra-low-voltage (ELV) circuits must be segregated or insulated to prevent interference and maintain safety ....
