Article Overview

Optical fiber cables are installed in protective ducts using trenching or directional boring, with careful attention to conduit type, cable handling, and industry standards to ensure long-term performance.

Planning and Site Preparation

Before construction, it is essential to locate existing underground utilities to avoid accidental damage and comply with safety regulations (FOA) . The route should be surveyed, and permits obtained if required. In urban areas, pre-existing conduits may be available, reducing the need for new trenching . Extra conduits are often installed to accommodate future cable expansions without additional excavation .

Trenching and Conduit Installation

Trenches are typically 1–1.2 meters (3–4 feet) deep, with deeper burial in cold climates to prevent frost damage . Conduits are usually PVC or HDPE, providing flexibility and protection against environmental stress . In industrial or high-security areas, steel ducts may be used for enhanced protection, while legacy networks may use concrete or FRP ducts . Innerducts or duct liners with pulling tapes are often pre-installed to facilitate cable installation . Conductive marker tape is buried above the conduit, usually no more than 300 mm below the surface, to aid future location and prevent accidental digging
