

Correct Method for Cable Trays to Pass Through Walls



Article Overview

Cable trays can pass through walls using wall penetrations with firestopping, cantilever or trapeze supports, and proper sealing to maintain safety and code compliance.

Wall Penetration Techniques

When routing cable trays through walls, the first step is to create a reserved opening in the wall that accommodates the tray width and allows for future maintenance. Openings should be carefully measured and cut to avoid structural elements and existing utilities . For finished walls, specialized tools like rotary cutters or jab saws can be used to minimize damage to drywall or plaster .

Support Methods

Cable trays passing through walls require adequate support to prevent sagging or mechanical stress. Common methods include:

- Cantilever wall brackets: Mounted directly to the wall to support vertical or horizontal tray runs .
- Trapeze hangers: Suspended from ceilings or structural members for overhead sections . The choice depends on the building structure, tray route, and load requirements. Proper spacing and secure attachment are essential to maintain tray stability and prevent overloading
