Knockout Holes in Junction Boxes: Often made in metal or plastic junction boxes, these knockout holes are designed to allow the entry of electrical cables and wires. They are typically pre-punched, and a simple tool is used to remove the knockout piece to create the desired opening. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in. Material preparation: Prepare the required circuit breakers, wires, wiring ties and other materials, and ensure that they meet the design drawings and installation requirements. Dedicated Space: Dedicated electrical space is required for panel from the floor to a height of 1. Mounting Height: Mounting height of panelboards should not higher than 6 ft 7in.
