

Depth Reserved for Distribution Box



Article Overview

The reserved depth for a distribution box is the thickness of the box plus the thickness of the wall plastering.

Reserved Depth in Wall Installation

When installing a distribution box in a concealed manner, the reserved hole in the wall should be about 20mm larger than the box's length and width, and the depth should equal the thickness of the distribution box plus the plastering on the inner wall . This ensures the box sits flush with the wall surface and allows for proper finishing. If the box is embedded in masonry, it can be fixed by filling concrete between the box and the wall for stability .

Clearance and Accessibility Requirements

For safety and compliance, the National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that electrical panels, including distribution boxes, must have a minimum working space of 36 inches (914 mm) in depth in front of the panel to allow safe operation and maintenance . The panel door should open fully to 90°, and no equipment should extend more than 6 inches beyond the front of the panel .

Technical Considerations

- Ensure the box is firmly installed, level, and plumb, with vertical deviation not exceeding 3mm .
- Edges around the panel should be close to the wall, and contact surfaces coated...
