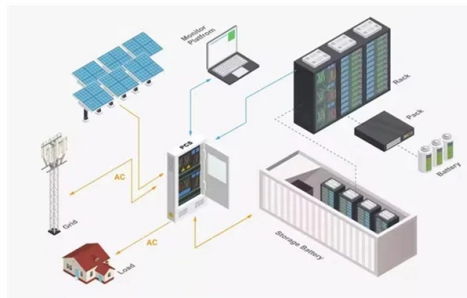


Detection using fiber optic sensors in narrow gaps



Overview

Here we present a new sensing method for realizing large-range displacement measurement in narrow space scenarios based on the combination of a fiber microprobe interference-sensing model and precision phase-generated carrier. A Fiber Sensor is a type of Photoelectric Sensor that enables detection of objects in narrow locations by transmitting light from a Fiber Amplifier Unit with a Fiber Unit. This is achieved by microprobe tilted-axis Gaussian optical field. With a Fiber-Optic Sensors designed for small object detection, the effective light axis is narrow, allowing for the light axis to be almost 100% blocked by the workpiece. This means changes in the amount of received light are large, ensuring stable detection. These advantages are essentially related to the optical fiber properties, i., small, lightweight, resistant to high temperatures and pressure, electromagnetically passive, among others.
