Fiber optic cables evolved from early light-guiding experiments in the 19th century to modern high-speed global communication networks, driven by innovations in low-loss glass, lasers, and digital transmission.

Early Foundations

The concept of guiding light dates back to the 19th century. In 1841, Daniel Colladon demonstrated total internal reflection by directing light through a stream of water, showing that light could follow a curved path with minimal loss, laying the foundation for fiber optics . Later, Jacques Babinet and other scientists explored similar principles, while Claude Chappe's optical telegraph in the late 18th century demonstrated early optical communication over long distances .

Mid-20th Century Experiments

In the 1950s and 1960s, researchers like Narinder Kapany and Harold Hopkins developed fiber bundles for image transmission, and Abraham Van Heel introduced cladding to reduce attenuation . Elias Snitzer and Will Hicks demonstrated laser light transmission through thin glass fibers, showing practical potential for communication .
