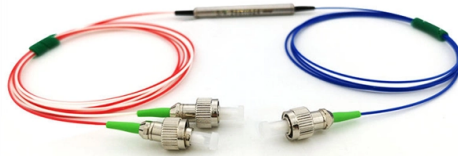

Electrical Distribution Box Placement

Height from the ground: For wall-mounted or ground-mounted electrical distribution boxes, the bottom edge is typically installed between 1.3 meters and 1.8 meters above the ground to allow comfortable operation and maintenance . Mobile or smaller enclosures may be installed slightly lower, around 0.6 meters to 1.5 meters, depending on ergonomic considerations . Consistency in height within the same building is recommended, with deviations not exceeding 10 millimeters . Location considerations: Install the box in a dry, well-ventilated, and easily accessible area. Ensure sufficient operating space around the box to accommodate at least two people for maintenance or emergency handling. Avoid corrosive environments, excessive moisture, or areas with obstructed access . The box should also be close to the power source to minimize power loss . Spacing from other components: Maintain adequate clearance for wiring, heat dissipation, and safety. Each circuit should have its own protection device, and wiring should follow proper color coding and insulation standards .
