Article Overview

SPDs should be installed in a tiered manner: Type 1 at the service entrance, Type 2 after the main breaker, and Type 3 near sensitive equipment, following spacing and code requirements.

SPD Placement in Distribution Boxes

Type 1 SPD: Installed at the main service entrance to protect against direct lightning strikes and high-energy surges. It is connected between the secondary of the service transformer and the line side of the main breaker, typically without upstream overcurrent protection .

Type 2 SPD: Placed after the main breaker in the distribution box to handle residual surges and switching spikes. This is the most common SPD for home and commercial distribution panels .

Type 3 SPD: Installed close to sensitive equipment such as computers, servers, or IT panels. This provides localized protection and ensures fast response to overvoltage events .

Spacing and Coordination

- Maintain 10 meters or more between a voltage switching SPD and a voltage limiting SPD.
- Keep 5 meters or more between two voltage limiting SPDs.
- If the SPD is more than 30 meters from the equipment, add another SPD near the...
