

Distribution box track spacing



Overview

Determine the appropriate trace width and spacing based on the current carrying capacity and the PCB manufacturing capabilities. Note: Refer to Specific UL standards for complete spacing details. Most power distribution blocks available today are actually terminal blocks, and are recognized to UL 1059, the Terminal Block standard. Proper spacing between components is essential for ease of assembly and maintenance, as well as to ensure that automated soldering processes can be carried out without causing bridging or other defects. High Speed Design Consideration: High-speed components, such as processors and memory modules. The installation height of the distribution electrical box should be controlled at 1. At least 1 meter of space should be reserved around the box to facilitate inspection, maintenance, and component replacement. These features help prevent. Recently, the National Electric Code (NEC) and UL508A began requiring that Power Blocks used in Feeder Circuits must carry voltage spacing greater than the traditional Industrial Control requirements.
