Wire numbers in a power distribution box (PDB) are used to maintain consistent identification across terminals, and can be propagated using jumper attributes or terminal utilities.

Wire Numbering Principles

In a PDB, wire numbers are typically assigned to both incoming and outgoing wires to ensure traceability and clarity in electrical schematics. The main principles include:

- **Consistency:** The wire number for an incoming wire should match the outgoing wire connected to the same terminal, avoiding confusion in multi-terminal setups .
- **Polarity and Safety:** Positive wires are usually connected to red terminals, negative to black, and ground to green, ensuring proper identification and safe operation .
- **Jumper Connections:** Internal jumpers can be used to link multiple terminals, allowing the same wire number to propagate across all connected points .

Implementing Wire Numbers in CAD or Electrical Design

For software like AutoCAD Electrical:

- **WD_JUMPERS Attribute:** This attribute allows terminals within a single PDB symbol to be internally jumpered. You define groups of terminals in parentheses, e.g., ((01 04 07 10 13) (02 05 08 11 14)), so that all terminals in a group share the same wire number .
- **JUMPERBAR Layer:** Using a JUMPERBAR wire type passes the wire number from ter...
