

Do fiber distribution boxes need to be grounded Why

Fiber distribution boxes with metallic components or conductive fiber cables must be grounded to ensure safety and compliance with electrical codes.

When Grounding is Required

Fiber distribution boxes (FDBs) must be grounded if they contain metallic components or if the fiber optic cables include conductive elements capable of transmitting stray current. This is particularly important when cables enter or terminate on the outside of buildings or are exposed to contact with power conductors, as specified in NEC 770.100 and related standards . For all-dielectric (non-conductive) fiber cables, grounding is generally not required unless metallic hardware is present .

Grounding Standards and Practices

- **National Electrical Code (NEC 770.100):** Requires conductive fiber optic cables to be grounded through a bonding or grounding electrode conductor. The grounding conductor should be as short as practicable, ideally less than 20 feet, and run in as straight a line as possible to the building's grounding electrode .
- **Grounding Conductor Size:** While NEC allows a minimum of 14 AWG, manufacturers often recommend a 6 AWG copper conductor for both bonding and grounding purposes .
- **Bonding Points:** Metallic components of the FDB, including doors and mounting pl...
