Article Overview

Angola does have fiber optic routers and extensive fiber optic networks, both domestically and via international submarine cables.

National Fiber Deployment

Angola has been actively expanding its terrestrial fiber optic network through the National Broadband Network project, which aims to deploy 1,980 kilometers of new fiber to connect underserved communities and extend fixed broadband access to approximately 3 million additional Angolans . This network is designed to complement existing infrastructure and is critical for achieving the government's target of 60% broadband penetration by 2027 .

Submarine and Domestic Fiber Systems

The country is connected internationally through several submarine fiber optic cables, including SAT-3/WASC, the West Africa Cable System (WACS), and the South Atlantic Cable System (SACS), linking Angola to Europe, South Africa, and Brazil . Domestically, the Angola Domestic Network System (ADONES) links eight coastal cities with 1,800 kilometers of fiber-optic cable . Angola Cables, a consortium of major telecom operators, manages much of this infrastructure and provides commercial fiber services .
