

Does a level 3 distribution box also need to be grounded



Overview

The metal box of the distribution box, the electrical installation board, and the metal base and casing of the electrical appliances in the box must be grounded. The protective neutral wire should be reliably connected through the terminal board. Avoid installing in a humid and corrosive environment to prevent equipment damage. Select a well-ventilated and dry place to avoid poor heat dissipation causing equipment. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.4 states the general requirements for grounding and bonding of electrical systems for both grounded and ungrounded systems. Ungrounded systems have high availability but involve significant risks.
