A double-layer cable tray consists of two stacked trays, allowing separate routing of different cable types, typically made of metal with open or ventilated designs for visibility and airflow.

General Structure

A double-layer cable tray features two horizontal levels of cable support, one above the other, often separated by a small vertical gap. This design allows for segregation of power and control or data cables, improving organization and reducing electromagnetic interference. Each layer can be a ladder-type, perforated, or solid-bottom tray, depending on the application and environmental requirements .

Materials and Finish

Double-layer trays are commonly made from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, with finishes such as pre-galvanized, hot-dip galvanized, or powder-coated to resist corrosion and wear . Aluminum trays are lightweight and naturally corrosion-resistant, while steel trays with galvanization provide sacrificial protection against rust .

- Open or ventilated sides: Allow visual inspection and airflow to prevent heat buildup .
- Rungs or perforations: Support cables while maintaining flexibility for cable entry...
