Overview

A dual-line parallel connection involves connecting two separate incoming lines or feeders to a distribution box so that the electrical load is shared between them. This setup is commonly used when a single line cannot handle the total current demand, such as in large homes, commercial buildings, or industrial facilities . By splitting the load, the system reduces the risk of overloading a single conductor and allows for more stable voltage distribution.

Benefits

- Increased capacity: Two lines can carry more current than a single line, effectively doubling the panel's power-handling capability .
- Load balancing: Electrical loads are distributed evenly, reducing stress on individual circuits and minimizing voltage drops .
- Redundancy and reliability: If one line experiences a fault, the other can continue supplying power, improving system reliability .
- Potential cost savings: Using parallel feeders can sometimes reduce the need for extremely heavy-gauge single conductors, lowering material costs
