Relays operate by detecting electrical quantities like current, voltage, or impedance, and they have defined pickup and reset levels to determine when to trip and when to return to normal operation . In homes, relays are often integrated with circuit breakers to provide primary or backup protection for sensitive appliances and wiring.
