

Elevator Secondary Distribution Box Configuration Requirements

An elevator secondary distribution box (SDB) receives power from the main distribution, distributes it to elevator circuits, and is configured with modular, protected, and monitored components for safety and reliability.

Overview of SDB Functionality

The Secondary Distribution Box (SDB) acts as an intermediary between the main power distribution and elevator systems. It receives power from the main distribution box via an extender cable and distributes it to branch circuits feeding elevator modules, emergency lighting, fans, and pumps . The SDB ensures centralized control, protection, and monitoring of elevator electrical loads while maintaining compliance with safety standards .

Modular Design and Configuration

Modern SDBs adopt a modular design, allowing flexible configuration based on project requirements . Key features include:

- Snap-on extender cables for easy connection to elevator floor modules .
- Terminal blocks for custom wiring and branch circuit connections .
