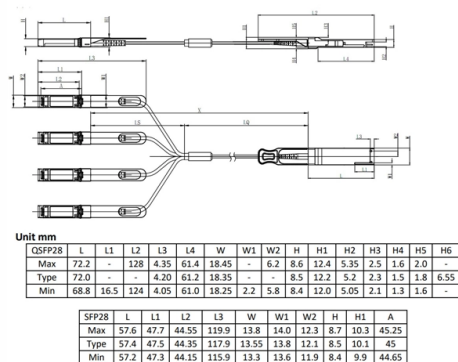


Emission Requirements Standards for Distribution Boxes

Distribution boxes must comply with chemical safety regulations like RoHS and REACH, and consider greenhouse gas emissions across their lifecycle, including transportation and supply chain impacts.

Chemical and Material Compliance

Distribution boxes are subject to RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) and REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation, and Restriction of Chemicals) regulations. RoHS restricts hazardous substances such as lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium in electrical components, ensuring that metals, plastics, and coatings used in distribution boxes are safe for humans and the environment . REACH requires manufacturers to register and evaluate all chemical substances used in production, including steel casings, plastic insulation, and paint pigments, to prevent unknown chemical risks from entering the supply chain . Compliance with these standards ensures that distribution boxes are environmentally responsible and legally marketable internationally.

Greenhouse Gas Emissions and Supply Chain Considerations

Emission requirements also extend to Scope 3 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, which include upstream transportation and distribution of components and finished products .
