Purpose of Relay Icons

They help engineers, technicians, and electricians quickly understand how a relay will respond to electrical conditions, such as overcurrent, undervoltage, or insulation failure, and how it interacts with other components in the system ().

Standards for Relay Symbols

There are two main standards for relay symbols:

- ANSI (American National Standards Institute): Uses a numbering system to indicate relay functions, often supplemented with letters for specific variations or amplifications of the function ().
- IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission 60617): Uses graphical symbols to represent relays and their functions, focusing on visual clarity and international consistency (). These standards allow engineers to convert between ANSI numbers and IEC symbols when reading or designing schematics.
