

Fabrication of connections between vertical and horizontal cable trays



Article Overview

Connections between vertical and horizontal cable trays are fabricated using specialized fittings, clamps, and support elements to ensure mechanical stability, proper load distribution, and secure cable routing.

Key Considerations

1. Fittings and Connectors

- Use elbows, T-pieces, and crossovers to change the direction of cable trays or connect vertical and horizontal sections. These fittings are designed to maintain structural integrity and allow smooth cable transitions ().
- For ladder or perforated trays, ensure that the fitting material matches the tray (e.g., steel, stainless steel, or aluminum) to prevent galvanic corrosion and maintain strength ().
- 2. Support and Hanger Placement
 - Vertical trays require secure attachment to walls, steel structures, or concrete using brackets, suspended supports, or center suspensions ().
 - Horizontal trays should be supported at intervals according to tray type: maximum 3 m for ladder trays and 2 m for perforated trays to avoid sagging or strain ().
 - When connecting vertical to horizontal trays, threaded rods with clamps and washers are commonly used to adjust height and alignment precisely ().
- 3. Fastening and Alignment
 - Use tray clips, clamps, and hex nuts to secure tray sections. For vertical trays, cables should be fixed with stainless steel strips (20 mm wide, two per meter) to pr...
