

Fiber Optic Cable Duct Installation



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables can be installed in ducts using either the pulling method for short distances or the air-blowing method for longer, continuous runs, with careful attention to bend radius, tension, and cable protection.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, a thorough survey of the cable route is essential. Inspect manholes, ducts, and innerducts to determine optimal splice points and duct assignments. Verify duct suitability using rodding or slugging, and calculate the required cable length, especially for factory-connectorized cables. Ensure the installation area is free of sharp objects, debris, or petroleum-based waste that could damage the cable sheath. Protective measures, such as barricades or cones, should be used when laying cable on surfaces exposed to traffic .

Pulling Method

The pulling method involves manually or mechanically pulling the fiber optic cable through pre-installed ducts using a rope or pulling line. This method is generally suitable for short distances, typically up to 200-300 meters between manholes or handholes. Key considerations include:

- Avoid exceeding the cable's maximum tensile load and minimum bend radius during pulling .
- Use figure-eight-loops when coiling cable to prevent twisting and torsion, with loop sizes typically 2-4 meters for standard cables
