

Fiber Optic Cable ECA Level Certification

Eca certification for fiber optic cables indicates compliance with EU fire safety standards, ensuring limited flammability and safe use in indoor installations.

What is Eca Certification?

Eca is a CPR (Construction Products Regulation) Euroclass for cables, defined under BS EN 50575 in the EU. It represents a basic level of fire performance, suitable for indoor installations where limited flammability is required. Cables classified as Eca have undergone testing to ensure they resist fire propagation, produce low smoke, and emit minimal toxic fumes during combustion, protecting both building occupants and critical infrastructure .

Testing and Compliance

To achieve Eca certification, fiber optic cables must pass vertical flame tests according to BS EN 60332-1-2, conducted by an authorised Notified Body. The tests evaluate:

- Flame propagation: Ensures the cable does not spread fire rapidly in confined spaces.
- Smoke emission: Limits visibility reduction during fire emergencies.
- Toxicity: Minimizes harmful gases released during combustion . Eca is considered a basic fire safety class, above Fca (highly flammable) but below higher classes like Dca, Cca, B2ca, or Aca, which require more stringent fire resistance and smoke control
